## 'The Sounds of Sirius – Songs to Soothe the Soul' - Lia Scallon 64 minutes

This CD is a compilation of tracks from all seven of Ms. Scallon's *Sounds of Sirius* titles. Her lilting accent and wonderfully melodic voice sooth and calm frazzled nerves. What a delight!

The compilation includes healing works for children, women, men, animals, and the Earth. Ms. Scallion speaks on two of the tracks, and sings/chants in a language akin to ancient Sanskrit that she calls the language of the soul. It is harmonic, blending with the music in a way that seems to promote vibrational healing. The crystal bowls and bells in the background add to the enjoyable experience. As I listened to *Song of Love for the Animals*, my pets gathered around me and were soothed by the voice and music.
